

Gisborne Rowing Club: Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all club members, committee and volunteers participating in all activities of the Gisborne Rowing Club including the travelling to, and participating in regattas, training camps & all other rowing related activities.

It sets our expectations regarding the behaviour of our club members, rowing officials and members of the Gisborne Rowing Club and it applies to all on-water and off-water activities including all social media. The purpose of this code of conduct is to provide guiding principles for the expected behaviour of all that are involved with the Gisborne Rowing Club.

ROWERS/MEMBERS

Your Responsibilities:

- 1. Comply with all policies and guidelines outlined by the Gisborne Rowing Club.
- 2. Uphold the Gisborne Rowing Club in good light.
- 3. Meet all financial requirements.
- 4. Learn to work together as a team and not let your teammates down.
- 5. Act in a way that is respectful & considerate to others.
- 6. Conduct yourself in a manner that reflects true sportsmanship.
- 7. Comply with all reasonable requests from the coaching team, Club Captain and parent helpers.
- 8. Participate in all activities (where possible) of the club including, but not limited to: boat loading & unloading, rigging & de-rigging, working bees, cleaning up of the clubrooms etc.
- 9. Being responsible for the safety of yourself and your teammates.
- 10. Treating all Gisborne Rowing Club equipment and facilities with care.
- 11. Support other club members in their participation in rowing.
- 12. If you become aware of an athlete being bullied, intimidated or harassed, follow the complaints procedure.
- 13. Follow all safety procedures.
- 14. Observing any rahui that is placed on the rivers Waimata, Taruheru, and Turanga.
- 15. You cannot bring non members or expelled members to the club sheds or to use the Gisborne Rowing Club facilities and equipment.

PARENTS & CAREGIVERS

Your Responsibilities:

- 1. Comply with all policies and guidelines outlined by the Gisborne Rowing Club
- 2. Uphold the Gisborne Rowing Club in good light
- 3. Meet all financial requirements
- 4. Support & guide your Child/Ward to ensure that have a thorough understanding of the Code of Conduct
- 5. Contribute to & support all club activities where possible
- 6. Be respectful for the allocated start, finish and pick up times of training.
- 7. Be respectful toward our coaches & the decisions that they make
- 8. Abide by the Child Protection Policy
- 9. Keep Coaches informed of medical conditions, absenteeism and any other matters concerning your child that may affect their training.

Any breaches of this code of conduct could lead to membership expulsion or refusal of future membership . This remains at the discretion of the Gisborne Rowing Club Executive Committee.
